Grass Tetany Warning

Currently, we are seeing a good deal of Grass Tetany around the area. Several vets have also commented to me that they are seeing higher than usual levels of Tetany for this time of year, particularly in the area to the East of Cobden. Given this, we are currently suggesting that farmers consider including a preventative level of magnesium in the dairy feed. The addition of Causmag will generally add around \$2-4/tonne to the cost of feed and when compared to the cost of dead cows, it seems cheap insurance. Please call me to discuss your feed situation.
